These steps are repeated for each memory verse.

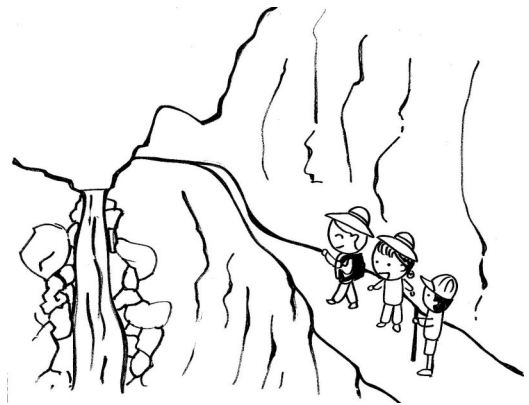

TESTIMONY 1 : GOD HAS POWER OVER NATURE

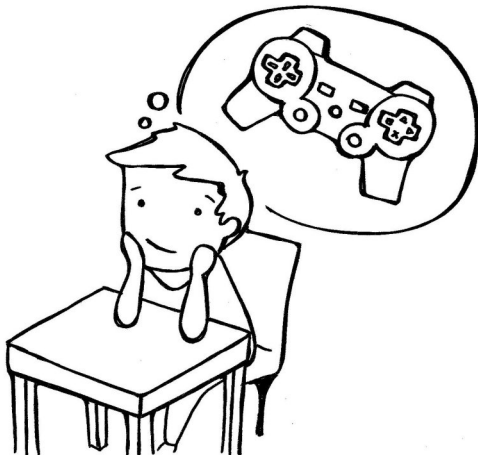

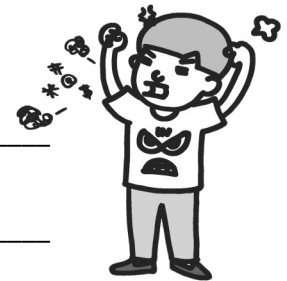


Walking in Obedience

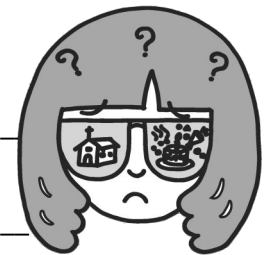


Walking in the Power of the Holy Spirit

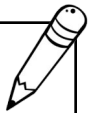
