How can I GLORIFY GOD?

Instructions: Read each scenario and discuss the questions below.

Scenario 1: The Math Quiz

As soon as Peter enters into the classroom, his teacher announces that there is a math quiz today. He is already in trouble with his mother over his previous failed math quiz. He will be in even bigger trouble if he fails this test as well. As he sits down in his seat, his friends come to him, telling him that they have a “cheat sheet” for all of them to use. Peter hesitates since he is afraid of getting caught, but his friends tell him that it’s fine and that they have already done it before without getting caught.

2. Which choice would be easier for Peter? Why?
3. Which choice would glorify God? How do you know?

Scenario 2: The New Friend

It’s the Sabbath Day and Martha is so excited to go to church to catch up with her friends. She just received a new set of glitter pens, and she wants to show it to them. When lunchtime comes, she is about to run to her friends, but her mother pulls her aside and introduces her to a young girl that has just moved from China. Her mother tells her that she has to make the young girl feel welcome by sitting and talking to her during lunch and RE Class. In her heart, Martha really doesn’t want to because she wants to sit and talk with her friends. What should she do?
