# THE ALMIGHTINESS OF GOD

"Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable." (Isaiah 40:28)

### A. God Is Omnipresent

We call God omnipresent because He is everywhere at the same time and ever-present throughout all of creation. He is above all, through all, and in all (Eph 4:6).

- 1. God is above all: God is above time and space, and He exists beyond all of creation itself.
- 2. God is through all: God pervades all of creation. He is always close by and present for His children, dwelling among those who worship Him.
- 3. God is in all: Through the Holy Spirit, God dwells within us and helps us overcome the trials and temptations that we encounter in life.

### **B.** God Is Omnipotent

There is nothing too difficult for God because He is the source of all power. God's power is like Himself, infinite and incomparable. What are some ways He is omnipotent?

- 1. *In creation:* God is the maker of all matter and force, and He sustains creation through His omnipotence.
- 2. In relation to man: God is able to do the impossible in the lives of men.
- 3. Over angels: God has complete authority over angels, who serve Him and carry out His plans.
- 4. Over Satan: Even though Satan is known as "the prince of the power of the air" (Eph 2:2), the God that we worship is able to overcome and overpower him.

#### C. God Is Omniscient

God has complete knowledge of all things. As His creation, He knows everything about us, from the number of hairs on our head to our innermost thoughts, and even where and what we will be in the future, near and far. God not only knows what we do and say, but also what we think in our hearts.

### Life Application: Be a God-Fearing Person

1. What does it really mean to fear God? To fear God is to be aware that we are in the presence of a holy, just, and almighty God. The focus is on a sense of awe, respect, and adoration for the majesty of God. It is seeing God in all His glory and humbling ourselves before Him.
