Review

Teachers can reference this lesson to give them some ideas about questions to ask during a review lesson. The review can be in any format: a standard written quiz, a Jeopardy style game, a board game, etc. The important thing is to give the students a chance to review all the things they have learned in the past quarter. You can draw your review questions from the **Check for Understanding** sections in each lesson, as well as the **homework assignments**. Remember to include some **life application questions** to allow the students to apply what they have learned to their lives.

- Footwashing To have a part with the Lord. Baptizing – To have your sins washed away. Holy Communion – To be one with the Lord by eating His flesh and drinking His blood; we are remembering His death when we partake of the Holy Communion.
- 2. Satan tempted Jesus with lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and pride of life. We can rely on the word of God to help us resist temptation. Each time Jesus was tempted, He resisted Satan by quoting from the Bible. Likewise, when we find ourselves tempted by

something, we should remember what we have read in the Bible about overcoming temptation. The best way to overcome temptation is to follow Jesus' example, and the only way we can do that is by reading the Bible regularly and praying to God to strengthen us continually.

- 3. Answers may vary. Students will probably answer that they feel very special and happy that Jesus loved them so much that He died on the cross for them. We can show our love to God by obeying His commandments and loving others. God's love for us is so great that He sent His only Son to die for us. When we love others as God has loved us, we are doing exactly what God wants us to do.
- 4. Answers may vary. We can try to overcome this fear by remembering that God is with us, so we should have nothing to fear. It does not matter if our friends laugh at us or don't believe what we say; what matters is that we try our best to preach to others, even if they won't listen. The best thing we can do for our friends is to preach to them and bring them to know God.
- 5. Answers may vary. In order to stay on the narrow path, we must put away the things of this world and focus on God. We need to choose wisely and decide if movies, TV shows, or video games are glorifying to God. In addition, are these things getting in the way of worshipping God and taking time away from our Bible reading and prayer? The more time we spend on the things of this world, the less time we will have to spend with God. Most importantly, we must build our relationship with God when we are young, since it is the most important foundation for our faith.


