

### What did God say to Jacob whenever he moved?

Places Jacob Moved To	What did God say?

#### Separate from the World

Jacob and Joseph both knew that their stay in Egypt was only temporary, so they isolated themselves in Goshen. And they were right, because God fulfilled His promise hundreds of years later: Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt to return to their true homeland, Canaan. In the same way, we are also living temporarily on earth. One day, God will bring us to our true home in heaven with Him. We must always remain separate from the world around us so that we don't lose our heavenly home. But being separate doesn't mean locking ourselves up in a room and ignoring the world. It means upholding the teachings of the Bible. For example, instead of attending birthday parties or visiting our friend's house on Saturdays, we attend church, because it is Sabbath day.

If remaining separate from the world means upholding the teachings of the Bible, what are some ways we can keep ourselves separated? Look up each verse and write down what it says we should do.
