IV. Short Answer and Life Application

1. Omniscient means that our God is all knowing. Omnipresent

means that our God is everywhere at all times. Omnipotent means that our God is almighty and that there is nothing He cannot do. He is the one true God that can always see inside our hearts and know what we are doing at all times. He is the one true God that can always help us, even if we think a situation is impossible. For this reason, we should have a heart of joy and a heart of reverence when we worship the one true God. We can glorify God at school, at church, and at home by choosing to do things that will please God and by staying away from things that do not please God.

2. The Bible is important to us as Christians because it contains the guidelines for living as Christians and teaches us the right way to worship God. It also shows us the way to salvation. We can study the word of God by asking questions when we read the Bible. Also, we can live out and share the word of God by putting the teachings from the Bible into practice so that our friends and family will want to learn more about God and about the Bible.
3. There are many churches worldwide, but there is only one true church. The true church has three very important things: (1) it preaches the truth according to the Bible; (2) it has the abidance of the Holy Spirit; and (3) it has the presence of signs and wonders. As members of the true church, we can preach to those around us by sharing Bible stories or testimonies, or by inviting them to church and RE Class. Likewise, we can pastor our friends in church by praying for them and being good spiritual buddies.
4. The Holy Spirit is a promise from God, but we must first pray for it before we can receive it. We must have faith and believe that we will receive it, and then be earnest, humble, and repentant in our prayers. We will know that we have received the precious Holy Spirit when we begin speaking in tongue, but most importantly, it is the transformation that we undergo after receiving the Holy Spirit that will be the most obvious to those around us. We must allow the Holy Spirit to work within us and transform us into the children that God wants us to be!
5. In order to be saved, we cannot simply receive water baptism and the Holy Spirit and stop at that moment. Rather, we must continually live out our faith as Christians and always strive to do according to the will of God. We must not stray to the left or to the right on the path. Only if we stay obedient to the word of God will we be able to enter the narrow gates at the end of the path. On the day that Jesus Christ comes again, He will take up into heaven those whose names are recorded in the Book of Life. Everyone else will be cast into the lake of fire.
