Are we also growing in wisdom, stature, favor with God and favor with men? Look at the questions and rate your own growth by checking off the boxes to the right that best matches your answer.

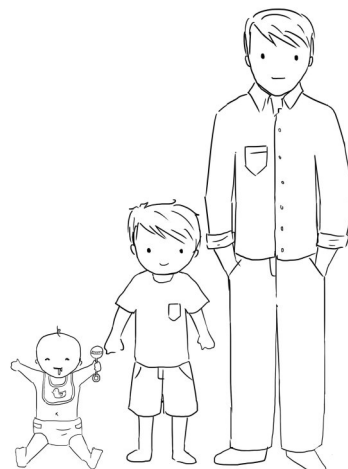
