### MEMORY VERSE FLASH CARDS

#### Instructions

- 1. Make copies of the memory verse flash cards for the students at the beginning of each quarter.
- 2. Cut out each memory verse and create a set for each student.
- 3. Notify each student's parents that our goal is to have students use these flash cards daily to help commit the verses to memory. Each day, their parents should remind them to review the verse and memorize it. By the end of the week, they will have the verse imprinted in their memory and heart. These steps are repeated for each memory verse.
