YEAR 3 BOOK 2 - "GOD, ANGELS, AND SATAN"

Book 2 aims to teach students about God's characteristics, of the roles of His angels in our lives, and about Satan's origins, purpose, and tactics. Students can then see how deeply the spiritual affects our physical and daily lives, and gain a greater understanding of the invisible war that we fight every day. The main objectives for this quarter are:
