A. The Name of Satan

Satan is actually a title that means "adversary." The title is quite fitting because Satan's sole purpose is to act against God and His people. Satan's other titles also indicate his character:

- 1. Devil (Mt 4:1)
- 2. Tempter (1 Thess 3:5)
- 3. Ruler of the world (Jn 14:30)
- 4. Great dragon and serpent of old (Rev 12:9)

B. The Origin of Satan

Lucifer, meaning "Day Star," was described as "perfect in beauty" (Ezek 28:12–14). But his beauty led to pride and the desire to exalt himself over God (Isa 14:12–15). Because of this, Lucifer was cast out of heaven and became our adversary, Satan.

- 3. Deceitful (2 Cor 11:14)
- 4. Unclean (Ezek 28:16–18)
- 5. Murderer (1 Pet 5:8)

D. The End of Satan

Satan is impossible to beat on our own, but Jesus Christ has already overcome Satan by overcoming death and opening a way for mankind to be saved (Heb 2:14). Satan strives to make us all fall, because he knows his ultimate fate is to be condemned to the lake of fire (Rev 20:10).
