# GOD'S BLUEPRINT FOR THE FAMILY

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 'Honor your father and mother,' which is the first commandment with promise: 'that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.'" (Ephesians 6:1–3)

## A. Family Roles According to the Bible

- 1. Husband and Wife (Eph 5:22–28): Husbands should love their wives as their own bodies, just as Christ gave Himself for the church. Wives should also submit to their husbands in the same way they submit to God with love.
- 2. Father and Mother (Eph 6:4; 1 Tim 5:14; Tit 2:4–5): Fathers should bring their children up in the Lord and avoid discouraging them, while mothers are taught to guide the house so that their children can learn how to submit to God.
- 3. Parent and Child (Deut 6:4–9; Ex 20:12; Eph 6:1–4): Parents are to teach their children to grow in the Lord by demonstrating the daily life of a Christian and raising them to keep the Sabbath. Children, for their part, should honor and obey their parents so that they can be blessed by God.
- 4. Siblings (1 Tim 5:1–2; Ps 133:1): Siblings can be a great blessing, but being a sibling can be a challenging role. With effort, this relationship can become one of the closest bonds in our lives.

# C. A Christian Household

- 1. God-Centered: A God-centered home is a place where family members speak, act, and relate to one another in accordance with the Bible's teachings.
- 2. Full of God's Love: When a household is full of love, the home becomes a refuge where hurt family members can find peace, comfort, and healing.
- 3. Full of Godly Discipline and Order
  - *a.* Spiritual discipline: When a family diligently searches out the truth of the Bible, they can then measure themselves by the standards that will never change: God's standards.
  - *b. Family discipline:* Discipline may seem harsh and unjust, but it is an important way of teaching right from wrong.

The word "discipline" can be defined as training ourselves to be orderly in our conduct. When such discipline is integrated into our character, we will live according to God's good purpose.
